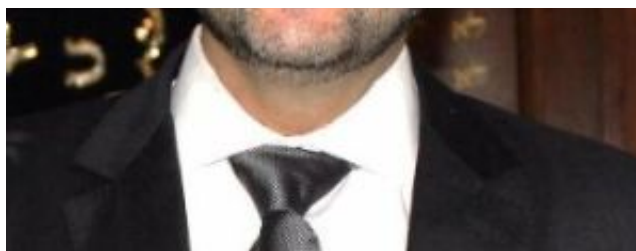

Rabbi Marty Waldman **Guest Speaker at The King's University** **Southlake, Texas** *By Matheus Guimaraes*

On January 23rd, Rabbi Marty Waldman was invited to speak at the The King's University in Southlake, Texas during their weekly chapel meeting. Attendees were undergraduate and graduate students, faculty members and guests.

Rabbi Marty talked about the vision of Toward Jerusalem Council II (TJCII) and its prophetic importance for the Church. He opened his message emphasizing the importance of taking advantage of the crucial time in our lives when we seek G0d with a first love, full of enthusiasm and zeal for His word.

Rabbi Marty spoke of the miracle of the Messianic Jewish movement, resurrected after two thousand years as a sign for today's Church about the coming of the Messiah and the special place in G0d's heart for the Jewish people. Yeshua prophesied that Jerusalem would not see Him again, until He is welcomed by His people as King, praising Him with the words in Psalm 118:26: ***Baruch Haba Be Shem Adonai – Blessed is He who comes in the name of the L0rd.***

Rabbi Marty made the following remark: *"In a study and latest poll, there is an estimated one million Jewish people who now believe in Jesus. This is phenomenal and I want to invite all of you to join those of us who are*

is phenomenal and I want to invite all of you to join those of us who are Jewish to say these words: **‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LOrd.’**“

“TJCII is a vision to reconcile Jews and Gentiles to fulfill what is written in Ephesians chapters 2 and 3, to become ONE NEW MAN based on Yeshua’s death, tearing down the wall of partition and his resurrection bringing Shalom between the two groups”, concluded Rabbi Marty.

TJCII is truly an initiative from the Spirit of G0d to guide the Church back to the “old path where the good way is” (Jer 6:16), back to G0d’s original plan of a reconciliation that will bring the restoration of Israel and the nations.
