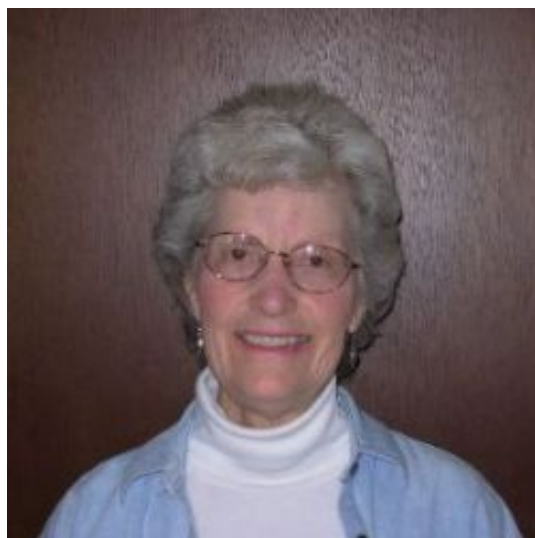


Arlene Stucki and TJCII

My Love Affair with TJCII

I was blessed to be called into Jewish ministry in 1973. In 2003, Rabbi Marty Waldman at Baruch HaShem Messianic Congregation in Dallas, invited my husband John and me to come to a TJCII North American Consultation in his congregation. We did not know anything about TJCII, but we were intrigued, and we attended.

It was love at first sight!

Here we heard Johannes Fichtenbauer and Rabbi Marty describe this vision of grace. We headed home knowing that this was an invitation from the LORD. It was to me that the call to Jewish ministry was extended, but John and I are a team.

Since then, we have had the privilege of being involved in this beautiful vision from the very heart of the LORD. I sat on the North

American Committee for several years and formed a TJCII intercessory team in Estes Park, Colorado where we were living. I was commissioned to prepare a TJCII Education Curriculum, with input from Fr. Peter Hocken of blessed Memory, which has been shared from pastors to laymen.

It was a blessing to help our Church in Estes Park turn from a Replacement Theology position to full support for Israel and Messianic Jewish ministry. We also began an Erev Shabbat Chavurah with both Jewish and non-Jewish believers to study the Torah Portions and share the Jewish Feast Days.

We held classes in the summer for tourists and locals to learn about the Jewish roots of the Christian faith, as well as encouraging Jewish folks to be engaged in the beauty of Jewish life. The attendance and interest of both Jews and Gentiles was more than we could have imagined.

We helped establish a TJCII Intercessory Team in Columbus, Ohio, led by Dawn Uhrick and now Barry and Janice Stewart lead that team. We also led many tour groups to Israel.

In 2013 we relocated to Lake Geneva, Wisconsin to be near our children. In these 6 years, we have been blessed to establish a strong TJCII Intercessory team, and we are currently helping them to see Yeshua in the Law of Moses and learn the beauty of the fullness of the Holy Scriptures.

Our Church has turned from Replacement Theology, and now supports Messianic Jewish ministry for the first time in her 100+ year history

We are now very senior citizens, but we know that TJCII is a vision we will serve as the LORD leads, so long as we have breath. We thank the LORD for this great privilege.
