TJCII'S Asian Mission in Singapore

"A Key Turning Point in the Vision of the One New Man"

The vision of TJCII is a Holy Spirit-breathed embodiment of Paul's vision of the One New Man in Ephesians and an expression of Yeshua's (Jesus) prayer for unity in John 17. It envisions the reconciliation of Jewish and Gentile followers of Jesus as an icon of the alignment of Israel and the

Gentile followers of Jesus as an icon of the alignment of Israel and the nations during this Godly-ordained season of restoration prior to the return of Jesus.

From a small group of Messianic Jewish and Gentile church leaders gathering in Dallas in 1995, TJCII has grown into a global movement centered in Jerusalem, capturing the hearts of senior leaders, intercessors and next-generation leaders. It has spread to Europe, North and South America, the Middle East and Africa.

TJCII's focus is now turning on to Asia starting with a TJCII Meeting in Singapore on September 18-20, 2019, where the TJCII International Leadership Council (ILC) will meet with top Asian leaders to share the TJCII vision, to learn from them the situations in their nations and to build relationships of trust.

Why Asia now and why Singapore? One of the functions of the ILC when it meets outside of Jerusalem is to serve as a “Moving Tabernacle”. During the ILC meeting in Jerusalem last October 2018, the members came into a strong consensus of conviction that the 2019 ILC meeting should be held in Singapore. During my recent diplomatic mission with Dr. Daniel Juster to China, Japan, Singapore and Korea, the following key insights emerged that confirmed this conviction:

1. Asian leaders have a strong sense that Asia's time on the forefront of world missions is **now** and that Europe and America will begin receding in their leadership roles.

2. There is a strong and growing love for Israel among the newer charismatic churches of Asia, but it is limited to praying for Israel and pilgrimages to the Holy Land. During our two conferences with some Asian leaders, Dan and I pointed out that the next logical step for churches would be to embrace TJCII for their focus on Israel.
3. We are on the cusp of a historic shift in world mission, from a focus on taking the gospel to the nations to a focus on Israel, including the salvation of the Jewish people and the alignment of the nations with Israel.
4. There is a small but growing mobilization of missionaries especially from the underground churches of Mainland China to make the journey along the road to Jerusalem.
5. Singapore is spiritually prepared for TJCII. Our Singapore meeting will be held at the Chiangi Cove Hotel and Conference Center on September 18-20, 2019. We met with the hotel owner, retired Supreme Court Justice Philip Pillai. After Dan and I prayed and worshipped with him, he spoke prophetically to us and said:

“Not only should TJCII come to Singapore, the Lord has prepared the way ahead of you and you will experience new revelation from the Holy Spirit that will profoundly change the trajectory of the TJCII vision. TJCII is bringing a gift to Asia, but it will receive a greater gift in return.”

Thus, TJCII is coming to Asia in the fullness of time.
