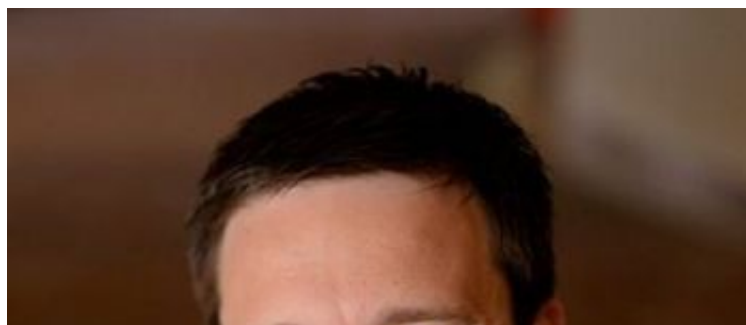

In May 2015, I was living in Jerusalem with my wife, Tabatha, and our kids. We had recently sold our ownerships in a few businesses and were spending the year in Israel as I was getting a Master's degree from The Hebrew University.

Dr. Wayne Wilks, a longtime member of the TJCII ILC, was in Jerusalem leading a tour for Gateway Church. I had known about TJCII through my involvement as a donor and board member of the Messianic Jewish Bible Institute (MJBI). I knew that Wayne's life had been greatly impacted by his involvement in TJCII over many years.

At an Aroma coffee shop in Jerusalem, Wayne suggested that I pray about becoming more involved with TJCII. My Roman Catholic upbringing, paired with my calling to Jewish ministry, led to an immediate desire to be a part of what the L-rd was doing through TJCII.

After moving back to Texas, Tabatha and I became members at Baruch HaShem Messianic Synagogue. Rabbi Marty approached me to prayerfully consider joining the TJCII legal board of directors. I was thrilled, and joyfully accepted.

Almost four years later now, the L-rd recently led me to resign from three of the six nonprofit boards on which I had been serving for many years. When I prayed over all six of these positions, I knew clearly in my heart that I was to continue serving T.JCII

Why? Because I feel there is no other ministry like TJCII on earth. The theology and spirit of TJCII is contagious, because I believe it so accurately reflects G-d's heart. Reuniting Jewish and Gentile believers in Yeshua is the most intimate, healing, and powerful initiatives possible.

As I have circled the globe traveling for MJB, I have come face-to-face with the volunteers for TJCII in nations from Korea to Hungary to Poland to Brazil. I am always left speechless by the humility, love and fruitfulness of these faithful servants of Yeshua.

TJCII has long been a very quiet, steady initiative that is tackling one of the greatest wounds in the Body of Messiah. I enthusiastically serve on the legal board for TJCII because I believe the reuniting of Jews and Gentiles in Yeshua is one of the most intimate concerns on the heart of G-d. Whatever small part I can play to see this vision become reality is an honor for me.
