TJCII Korea Prayer Points

1. Currently, the Korean government is forcing stricter regulations against the Church than other religions and commercial facilities in the name of COVID-19. Please pray for Korean church to wake up to her destiny and bear the vision of TJCII in this tough

situation.

2. Under the strict regulations, TJCII Korea cannot have TJCII meetings. Before COVID-19, the TJCII Korean team gathered together to meet and pray. Now Jacob Lee is trying to remain connected through calling and visiting the leaders personally. Please pray for the leaders of TJCII Korea who attended the TJCII Singapore Consultation in 2019: Dong Gu Kim, Samuel Byungju and Deborah Chung, Ben Torrey, Kwang Sik Kang, and Jeong Jacob Lee.

3. TJCII Korea has been meeting with the TJCII Executive Committee over Zoom. These calls provide wonderful opportunities to see TJCII leaders and the other TJCII Asia coordinators. Please pray for continued strength during this difficult season.

4. TJCII Asia is hoping to coordinate a TJCII Virtual Conference in the fall to help inspire and teach a broader range of people. Many Korean leaders and young adults may join it and have the opportunity to hear the messages from TJCII ILC members. Please pray for the coordination process and for communication and participation in this conference.

5. The Korean leaders of TJCII were blessed during the TJCII Singapore Consultation in 2019. Many have shared the vision of TJCII in their congregations and with their colleagues. Please pray for the development and propagation of the TJCII vision in Korea.

6. Please pray for the next generation so that young leaders can catch the vision of TJCII and support their senior leaders. Please pray for a young person to partner alongside Jeong Jacob Lee. This young partner needs to be someone who is capable of speaking English and would need to help coordinate the work of TJCII with Korean and Asian leaders.
