Toward Jerusalem Council II and the Navajo Nation

Two weeks ago, several key leaders of TJCII convened on a Zoom call to interface with Navajo Nation Vice President Myron Lizer. Some background for you: VP Lizer journeyed to Jerusalem late in 2012 as part of a delegation headed by former Navajo President Ben Shelly (Hebrew translation “Son of Mine”). That delegation presented the Knesset with A Declaration by the First Nations of America on 12/12/12.

VP Lizer was recently elected to office. He has no previous background in politics. He is a full-blooded member of the First Nations – half Navajo and half Comanche. He is both a pastor and business owner (three Ace Hardwares & three Churches Chickens). He has been to the Oval Office and was present for the recent signing of the Lady Justice Executive Order to bring justice for missing and murdered women across the First Nations reservations – a chronic problem. VP Lizer is currently overseeing a massive federal grant for developing adequate water and hygienic resources to combat his nation’s very high death toll from the Covid-19 virus.

Robert Wolff has supported TJCII for many years. He organized the 2012 Holy Land outreach. Messianic Rabbi Wolff and VP Lizer initiated The Many Waters Foundation. The first goal of this partnership is to bridge the First Nations of America and Israel by sending promising native American students to the Arava Institute in the Negev to be educated in Israeli agricultural, water, technological and industrial skills that can be applied back on their homelands. The connection between Israel and the First Nations is a natural fit. Both groups are tribal, have nomadic and diasporic heritages. Both have survived millennia of persecution and existential challenges. Like Israel, the First Nations trace their historical faith to one great Creator.

VP Lizer's love for the Jewish roots of his faith and desire to work with Israel has been confirmed by relationships with numerous leaders in Messianic and traditional Jewish groups. He has excellent standing with other First Nations leaders and has gained favor with the highest echelons in the Oval Office and Cabinet.

TJCII leaders are eager to be associated with VP Lizer, along with other First Nations leaders also interested in sharing resources with Israel. This budding partnership offers a grassroots, peer group approach to further credibility with our Gentile family as One New Man.
